

Neck, Jaw, Head – Intraoral Massage

Manual therapy techniques inside the oral cavity are extremely valuable when working with clients with temporomandibular joint (TMJ) dysfunction, headaches, whiplash and a host of other issues.

This workshop presents an in-depth exploration of the neck, jaw, cranium, and oral cavity, including plenty of hands-on intraoral techniques. Hands-on work will be integrated with precise anatomy and palpation skills, so that you can safely, effectively, and confidently work inside the mouth. Techniques will be drawn from craniosacral therapy, neuromuscular and myofascial techniques, positional release and more, and will be tailored to the needs and experience of the class participants.

Audience: Over the years, I have had practitioners in the following professions benefit from attending this class: Massage, physical therapy, speech therapy, dental hygiene, dentist, acupuncture, and chiropractic.

Intraoral Massage Endorsement for LMPs: Washington State now authorizes licensed massage practitioners to use intraoral massage techniques, provided those practitioners have an Intraoral Endorsement on their massage license. This class satisfies the WA State 16-hour training requirement for intraoral endorsement.

Dave Campbell, BA, LMP, is an instructor of kinesiology and cadaver anatomy for the Spectrum Center School of Massage in Lake Stevens, WA since 2001. He has been in practice for over 20 years and has an enduring fascination with the intricacies of the human body, mind, and spirit. Dave maintains a full-time practice at The Natural Health Clinic in Bellingham, WA, specializing in Craniosacral Therapy and Visceral Manipulation, augmented by a variety of other gentle fascial release techniques.

Dave is the author and illustrator of the book *Mastering Muscles & Movement: A Brain-Friendly System for Learning Musculoskeletal Anatomy and Kinesiology*. He holds a B.A. in Mathematics from the University of California. A former key engineer at the Fairchild Research Labs in Palo Alto, CA, Dave developed his brain-friendly approach to teaching muscles and movement based on years of experience in the study of human perception, artificial intelligence, and graphic representation of scientific information.
